CEI to Provide Technical Assistance to U.S. EPA

Comprehensive Environmental Inc. CEI has been involved in TMDLs since the 1992 rule requiring states to prepare 303(d) lists of impaired waters. Many of our clients have had to incorporate TMDL considerations in their Phase II annual reports and CEI has already revised many stormwater management plans to reflect local TMDLs. Through this work, we have reviewed and critiqued many TMDLs from a base of experience of how to make them scientifically valid and cost-effective to implement.
