

CEI Staff Now Certified Floodplain Managers

CEI is proud to announce that two principal CEI staff are now Certified Floodplain Managers (CFM). Mr. Matthew Lundsted, P.E. and Mr. Michael Ohl, P.E., both Principal Engineers at CEI, have obtained their CFM through the Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM). The ASFPM grants CFM certification to professionals who meet the requirements and complete a comprehensive examination on the programs and standards to reduce flood losses in the nation. CFM's have a working knowledge of flood studies and maps, National Flood Insurance Program rules and regulations, regulatory standards, ordinance administration, flood insurance, hazard mitigation and natural/beneficial floodplain functions.
