

NEWWA Past Presidents Award Goes to CEI Water Resource Engineer

Ms. Berger along with Dennis Water District's Sheryl McMahon were given this honor for their publication entitled "Innovative Methods to Implement Affordable Treatment and Inform Decision Makers in Dennis, Massachusetts," published in the Journal of the NEWWA, Vol. 124, No. 2, June 2010.

Ms. Berger and Ms. McMahon's paper presented the factors affecting the Dennis Water District's (Dennis, MA) decision to treat its groundwater for the removal of iron and manganese, how to effectively convey that message to the public and ultimately how to implement treatment in an efficient and affordable manner. Highlights of implementation of water treatment from conception using a feasibility study through construction are provided.

The NEWWA Past Presidents Award is presented for the most meritorious paper by a group of authors in the Journal of the New England Water Works Association published the preceding year.
