
Stormwater Utilities Latest Topic at NEIWPCC Regional Workshop



On March 25, 2015 the New England Interstate Water Pollution Control Commission (NEIWPCC) conducted a Regional Stormwater Utility Workshop in Chelmsford, MA to address the increasing interest in municipal stormwater funding options. CEI Principal Engineer Michael Ohl, P.E., CFM participated in this event by presenting *Lessons Learned in Stormwater Utility Development*.



Many municipalities struggle to achieve regulatory compliance on stormwater issues, due to funding limitations. This presentation discusses the specific obstacles encountered by one New England community in considering a stormwater utility as one option to close the funding gap for stormwater regulatory compliance and infrastructure maintenance and improvements. Ultimately, this community valued the need for additional funds to protect the Town's investment in its stormwater system and to protect its water resources, electing to increase the general funds dedicated to its stormwater needs.
