

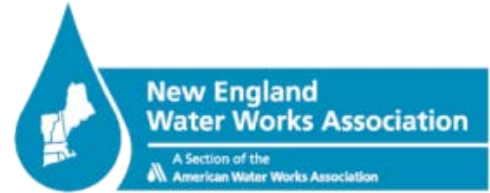

CEI at NEWWA 2014 Spring Conference

The New England Water Works Association 2014 Spring Conference and Exhibition held in Worcester, MA on April 2nd and 3rd drew a crowd of over 2,800 water works professionals. CEI hosted a booth in the exhibition hall and was represented in the technical presentation sessions. CEI's Kristen Berger, P.E., ENV SP, moderated in several sessions and presented: "Kingston Water Supply Management Protocol – A SWMI Grant Project." This project was funded through the Sustainable Water Management Initiative (SWMI) Grant Program administered by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection. The goal of the project was to demonstrate how a water system, specifically Kingston, could effectively manage use of its sources to benefit both drinking water supply and the environment as they relate to the SWMI framework. This presentation was especially timely with the recent release of the draft SWMI regulations.
