CEI Works with Franklin Pierce University to Tackle Pearly Pond

Keene, NH – CEI is pleased to be working with Franklin Pierce University and the NH Department of Environmental Services (NH DES) to develop a watershed management plan for Pearly Pond. Located adjacent to the University, Pearly Pond is an impaired waterbody due to excessive phosphorus, causing nuisance aquatic blooms that negatively impact water quality, aquatic wildlife and recreational usage. The plan will assess existing conditions and watershed impacts to the pond while prioritizing recommendations to improve Pearly Pond's water quality.



This project is being funded by a Watershed Assistance grant from NH DES and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Clean Water Action Section 319 Funds. Matching funds and volunteer time have been provided by Franklin Pierce University, the Pearly Pond Association, the Pearly Pond Management Advisory Committee, the Rindge Conservation Commission, and the Rindge Planning Board.
