



### CEI Works with VTrans to Lead Research in Transportation Stormwater Management

CEI and the Vermont Agency of Transportation (VTrans) just recently published the final report for The Stormwater Practices Research Project, culminating a year-long effort to identify and evaluate new technologies for stormwater management particularly suited for Vermont's linear transportation infrastructure.

The research included:

- A comprehensive literature search and consultation with DOTs, environmental agencies, and other stormwater management practitioners throughout the country.
- Identification of treatment practice selection criteria, followed by application of these criteria to the technical evaluation of practices identified by the search.
- Compilation of a suite of recently developed and emerging structural stormwater practices suitable for roadways, together with information to support development of future technical manuals and design standards for application to VTrans facilities.

The research is also intended to support future collaboration between VTrans and the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources Stormwater Program, to enhance state regulatory requirements and guidance related to stormwater solutions that fit the unique constraints of long linear infrastructure projects.
