Throughout 2014 CEI was part of an on-call team working with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the City of Providence and the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management to design and install a Green Infrastructure (GI) Education and Outreach Project bio-infiltration system at J.T. Owens Park. This project helps treat stormwater runoff and reduce nonpoint source pollution from entering nearby Mashapaug Pond. Put online in late summer of 2014, this project will help improve the water quality of Mashapaug Pond and also serve as a demonstration project to help encourage area developers, planners and engineers to use green infrastructure techniques similar to this in future designs.
