## Preserving Fawn Lake



CEI is currently working with the Town of Bedford to complete a preservation study for Fawn Lake. Fawn Lake is a 12-acre man-made waterbody with passive recreational uses. CEI is currently evaluating information on alternative lake management strategies to address the significant growth of aquatic plants in Fawn Lake, a valued conservation and passive recreation area for the Town. CEI has completed the mapping of pond bathymetry and soft sediment depths along with sediment sampling. CEI will address short and long-term alternatives to address the increase in aquatic growth, decrease in water quality, increase in sedimentation and the future of area recreational activities.
