

New Britain Brownfields Demolition and Remediation Underway



Earlier this year CEI began working with the City of New Britain on a Municipal Brownfields Assessment and Remediation Grant from the State of Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development. With several downtown parcels targeted, CEI worked to assess these parcels and develop demolition and remediation plans and specifications to move this area on its way to redevelopment.

On October 26, 2015, New Britain Mayor Erin E. Stewart (pictured) led the building demolition and abatement phase of this project. New Britain Municipal Development Director Mr. Ken Malinowski kicked off the event followed by Mayor Stewart, Commissioner James Redecker of CT DOT and Deputy Commissioner Timothy Sullivan from the CT DECD Office of Brownfield Remediation and Development.

CEI will be working with the City through 2016 to oversee the abatement, remediation, and demolition of the former Police Facility and the request for proposal for a developer to redevelop the site into a mixed use development. The site is adjacent to the CTfastrak bus rapid transit (BRT) terminal station, and is located within a transit oriented development (TOD) district.
