CEI recently attended the New England Water Environment Association (NEWEA) 2016 Annual Conference and Exhibit. Throughout the last week of January in Boston, MA, several CEI staff attended and presented at this multi-day event that drew over 2,300 water quality professionals.

CEI Principal Engineer Rebecca Balke, P.E., LEP, presented at NEWEA's Watershed Management technical session on Approaches to Watershed Management. Her presentation on *Managing Phosphorus Loads to Pearly Pond* focused on CEI's collaborative efforts with the NH DES, Franklin Pierce University, the Pearly Pond Management Advisory Council and the Town of Rindge, NH to develop a Watershed Restoration Plan that identified phosphorus sources and corrective methods.



Later in the week, CEI Principal Engineer Matthew Lundsted, P.E., CFM, presented at NEWEA's Watershed Nitrogen Tracking and Accounting technical session. His presentation on *How New Methods of Nitrogen Treatment for Stormwater are Designed to Help the Cape and Other Coastal Municipalities Meet Nitrogen TMDLs* was co-presented with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and focused on Green Infrastructure.
