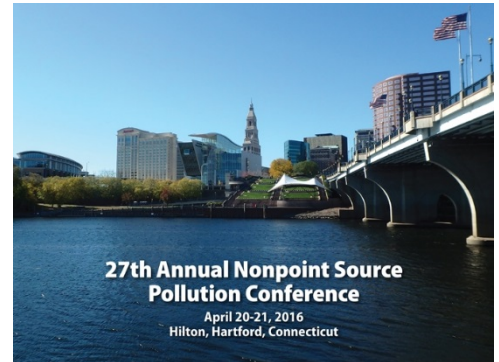

CEI Talks Stormwater – Annual Nonpoint Source Pollution Conference
