As part of a Joint Venture, this CEI led team was recently selected for an on-call contract to provide the USACE New England Division with Architect-Engineer Services for Hazardous, Toxic, and Radiological Waste (HTRW) Projects within the North Atlantic District (NAD).

This 5 year, \$2.5M contract may include:

- Design and implementation of remediation strategies/options to include identification, pilot testing and application of innovative and/or alternative treatment technologies;
- Geological, geotechnical, geothermal and geophysical investigations;
- Groundwater investigation and modeling;
- Soil and sediment investigation;
- Vapor intrusion investigation and mitigation techniques;
- Environmental chemistry data collection, management and interpretation;
- Preparation of human health and ecological risk assessments, and providing toxicology, health physics and industrial hygiene expertise;
- Familiarity with and experience in DoD environmental investigation and cleanup with local, state, and Federal regulatory requirements to include negotiations with regulatory agencies;
- Optimization, operation and maintenance of HTRW remediation systems; and
- Engineering services during construction of HTRW remediation projects.
