Tier II Reports Due

Emergency and Hazardous Chemical Inventory Forms, otherwise known as Tier I or Tier II Inventory Forms, are due March 1, 2017. Regulated facilities are required to submit these forms annually to State Emergency Response Commissions (SERCs), Local Emergency Response Commissions (LEPCs), and local fire departments.



These requirements are part of the 1986 Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) to help increase the public's knowledge and access to information on chemicals at individual facilities, their uses, and releases into the environment and to promote chemical emergency preparedness and prevention through collaboration and planning.

Facilities that store hazardous chemicals above certain threshold quantities, are required to prepare and submit Tier I or Tier II Forms. The threshold quantity for most hazardous substances is 10,000 pounds, and 500 pounds for extremely hazardous substances (EHS). Information on the type, quantity and storage conditions of chemicals stored on site is provided.
