Renewable Energy for Water & Wastewater

In February 2012 CEI Regional Program Manager and Senior Engineer Sebastian Amenta, P.E. presented a seminar on *Renewable Energy Sources for Water and Wastewater Facilities*. Given at the Annual Technical Conference and Vendor Expo (ATCAVE) Connecticut Section of the American Water Works Association held in Cromwell, CT, Mr. Amenta's session focused on how water and wastewater systems can achieve significant cost savings and incentives through the use of renewable energy resources. His presentation provided information on the use of renewable energy alternatives for municipal and private facilities including hydrodynamic, geothermal and solar. Specific examples of alternative uses were discussed along with associated costs and state and federal incentives.
