

GETTING TO KNOW CEI – ROBERT HARTZEL

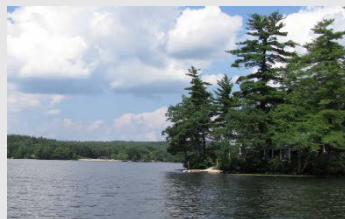


Bob Hartzel, CLM, CPESC
