CEI Water Treatment Facility Featured on NEWWA Journal Cover

CEI is pleased to announce the successful completion and operation of the Auburn Water District's West Street Water Filtration Facility, Auburn, MA. On-line since Fall 2016, the facility removes arsenic, iron and manganese from two of the District's wells. This filtration facility is the culmination of three years of combined efforts by the Auburn Water District and CEI, starting with a treatment feasibility and pilot study and finishing with design and construction. The primary process is pressure filtration with GreensandPlus media equipped with a state-of-the-art automated filter control system.



The project was successfully completed within budget and was funded in part through the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program. CEI provided study, design, permitting, bid, construction, startup and funding administration services.

The facility is featured on the cover of the New England Water Works Association (NEWWA) Journal, June 2017 issue. The NEWWA Journal, in its 131st year, is the foremost publication focused on drinking water in New England.
